TRANSFORMATION

After the extraction, natural cork planks will be stacked to rest in the open air for some months, releasing its sap and moisture contents. They are then boiled, which leads to changes such as an increase in volume. After drying, they are sorted based on quality and cut into appropriate bars. Even planks showing defects are utilised, as cork is never wasted.

Cork is soft, lightweight, versatile, impermeable, insulating, highly durable, and dust and dirt repellent.

Likewise it is circular and eco-friendly, being 100% natural, renewable, recyclable, and biodegradable.

The unique physical and chemical properties of cork cannot be replicated artificially.





GLUE	We use a water-based adhesive (mixture of copolymer dispersions and additives in aqueous media), free of dangerous substances, instead of a more chemical and aggressive as it often happens.
PROTECTOR	The hydrophobic protector, a mixture of surfactants, additives and organic solvents in an aqueous solution, is a top coating applied during the final stage of cork fabric manufacturing, reinforcing cork's natural features: - improves water resistance; - adds resistance to sun exposure, scratches, stain and dirt;
	- enhances resistance to abrasion (Abrasion Resistance of Textile Fabrics Test (ASTM 3884-92; Taber test: 500g, CS17) > 8000 Cycles)
	This product acts as a protective layer that enhances the durability and longevity of the cork fabric, thus maintaining its quality and appearance over time. Specifically designed for our products, rigorous testing confirmed its safety, no heavy metals compounds, formaldehyde, or volatile organic compounds (VOCs) were detected,
COLOURS	ensuring it poses no risk to human health or the environment.
	Our coloured cork fabric is created by adding selected pigments into our specially formulated cork protector, which is then skilfully hand-painted onto the cork fabric. These colour agents were tested by an accredited lab, and they meet safety standards, making coloured cork fabric suitable even for toddlers' toys and clothing.

Twill and denim, in different weights, are preferred choices, but tests with flannel and corduroy have also shown promising results.
